Persons of Hispanic origin represent 3.8% of the population in the identified area compared to 17.6% of the U.S. population. Persons of Hispanic Origin may be of any race. The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 17.2 in the identified area, compared to 63.0 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current median household income is \$40,650 in the area, compared to \$53,217 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$48,008 in five years, compared to \$60,683 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$55,567 in this area, compared to \$74,699 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$63,372 in five years, compared to \$84,910 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$24,591 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$28,597. The per capita income is projected to be \$28,094 in five years, compared to \$32,501 for all U.S. households

Currently, 50.0% of the 29,805 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 20.1%, renter occupied; and 29.9% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.7% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. In 2010, there were 28,412 housing units in the area - 51.9% owner occupied, 18.9% renter occupied, and 29.1% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.15%. Median home value in the area is \$173,441, compared to a median home value of \$200,006 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 4.82% annually to \$219,427.
