The five-year projection for the population in the area is 278,693 representing a change of 0.66% annually from 2015 to 2020. Currently, the population is 48.5% male and 51.5% female.

The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 53.7 in the identified area, compared to 63.0 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current median household income is \$41,986 in the area, compared to \$53,217 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$50,009 in five years, compared to \$60,683 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$56,245 in this area, compared to \$74,699 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$63,634 in five years, compared to \$84,910 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$22,992 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$28,597. The per capita income is projected to be \$26,028 in five years, compared to \$32,501 for all U.S. households

Currently, 53.4% of the 122,122 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 34.9%, renter occupied; and 11.7% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.7% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. In 2010, there were 117,754 housing units in the area - 57.4% owner occupied, 31.3% renter occupied, and 11.4% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.63%. Median home value in the area is \$139,507, compared to a median home value of \$200,006 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 5.22% annually to \$179,907.
