The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 72.0 in the identified area, compared to 63.0 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current average household income is \$77,863 in this area, compared to \$74,699 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$87,861 in five years, compared to \$84,910 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$31,208 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$28,597. The per capita income is projected to be \$35,179 in five years, compared to \$32,501 for all U.S. households

Currently, 51.7% of the 251,107 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 40.7%, renter occupied; and 7.7% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.7% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. In 2010, there were 247,721 housing units in the area - 54.5% owner occupied, 38.3% renter occupied, and 7.2% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 0.61%. Median home value in the area is \$229,740, compared to a median home value of \$200,006 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.02% annually to \$266,574.
